Terrorism

CERT volunteer's, along with the general public, play a critical role in identifying suspicious activities occurring with the community. There are typically eight signs of terrorism that signal potential terrorist activity.

Understanding the 8 Signs of Terrorism

Sign 1	Surveillance The targeted area is being watched and studied carefully.
Sign 2	Elicitation Information is gathered that is specific to the intended target.
Sign 3	Test of security Local security measures are tested and analyzed.
Sign 4	Funding Raising, transferring, or spending lost of money.
Sign 5	Acquiring supplies Necessary supplies are gathered to prepare the attack.
Sign 6	Impersonation People impersonating roles to gain access.
Sign 7	Rehearsal and dry runs Groups or individuals determine traffic flow
Sign 8	Deployment Deploying assets and getting into position.

VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION

PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The CERT Logistics Team Member position is an affiliated position within the Office of Emergency Management. CERT Logistics Team members are responsible for inspecting, maintaining, and transporting caches during disasters if needed. The team members will be responsible for cache inspection, inventory management, restocking, equipment assessment. During an activation the Logistics Team members will deploy and support CERT logistical needs (feeding, equipment support, shelter operations, and command post set-up etc.) of a neighborhood CERT team.

VOLUNTEER FUNCTIONS:

- Conduct equipment and inventory management of each CERT cache within the Fire District and provide status reports to CERT program manager relating to any procurement requests.
- Assist with drafting CERT disaster resource cache protocols.
- Assist with towing and/ or transporting CERT caches to affected disaster neighborhoods or any planned CERT training event.
- Assist with coordinating food, water and shelter operations for the CERT team members when activated or during training events.
- Assist with setting up Incident Command Post for the CERT teams during activations or during planned training events.
- Assists with coordinating “observation days” where CERT members can review disaster resource cache and get familiar with equipment resources.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:

Must be willing to commit to no notice activations and support volunteer disaster response activities. Must be capable of lifting 25lbs and moving containers if necessary and work in cramped spaces from time to time. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions. Demonstrate strong team-work traits, works well with the public, other employees and volunteers.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Must complete a Live Scan background check. Will have to provide copies of DMV records prior to being authorized to tow Fire District trailers.
