## APPENDIX A: PARTICIPATION LEVELS

### LEVELS

All community members are eligible to take CERT Basic Training and achieve *Level 1: Awareness* status, or take the additional steps needed to achieve *Level 2: Response* status. To reach *Level 3: Advanced* status, members are appointed at the discretion of the Community Volunteer Coordinator and status may be revoked at any time.

Upon completion of CERT Basic Training and IS-100 online course, all participants are eligible to participate in the Disaster Service Worker (DSW) swearing in process and be activated as a CERT responder if they choose to.

- **Level 1: Awareness**
  - Completed Basic CERT Training
  - Upon completion, a certificate will be issued.
  - Recommended to participate in a training class, refresher course, drill, or exercise at least every two years
  - No Disaster Service Worker (DSW) status
- **Level 2: Response**
  - Completed Basic CERT Training
  - Upon completion, a certificate and CERT ID card will be issued.
  - Required to participate in at least one training class, refresher course, drill, or exercise per year
  - Required to take IS-100 Intro to ICS Course; additional courses are optional
  - Complete DSW registration
  - Can staff CERT booths at community events and can be activated as a CERT responder
- **Level 3: Advanced**
  - Completed Basic CERT Training
  - Upon completion, a certificate and CERT ID card will be issued.
  - Required to participate in at least two training classes, refresher courses, drills, or exercises per year
  - Required to take IS-100 Intro to ICS Course, Basic First Aid/CPR, IS-200 ICS for Single Resources, IS-700 NIMS, Red Cross Shelter Ops/Fundamentals, Stop the Bleed; additional courses are optional
  - Complete DSW registration
  - Can staff CERT booths at community events and can be activated as a CERT responder
